Worst Roads campaign top ten list released

Final report includes three major Manitoba highways

Winnipeg, MB – The CAA Manitoba Worst Roads campaign top ten list contains seven roads from Winnipeg and three major Manitoba highways.

In addition to St. James Street taking top spot, Highway 21, 10 and 1 were elevated to spot two, four and seven respectively after the final tally was made.

CAA Manitoba analyzed the data by road, by community and by municipality to present a clear picture to government officials. The full report includes a full breakdown of where each vote was cast. This report was circulated to more than 100 municipalities earlier this week.

While the results are not scientific, CAA Manitoba Public and Government Affairs Manager Liz Peters said the results are important to keep the ongoing infrastructure condition and funding discussion top of mind for everyone – especially government.
