Daily	Itinerary Activity Level Moderate
Day 1	Depart Winnipeg to Dublin
Day 2	Belfast – Upon arrival, transfer to Belfast, en route, visit the Irish Linen Centre in Lisburn D
Day 3	Belfast – Take a Black Taxi City tour, including a visit to the Titanic Museum. Afternoon at leisure B/D
Day 4	Derry – Travel up the North Antrim Coast to visit the Giant's Causeway and continue to Derry B/D
Day 5	Galway – Depart to Galway, with stop at the Belleek Fine China Factory, Drumcliffe Cemetery and Ballintubber Abbey B/D
Day 6	Galway – Excursion to Connemara and visit the Kylemore Abbey and Gardens B/D
Day 7	Killarney – Depart to Killarney via the Wild Atlantic Way, with stops at Burren National Park and the Cliffs of Moher. Cross the Shannon River by ferry and continue to Killarney B/D
Day 8	Killarney – Excursion to Ring of Kerry and evening dinner at Kate Kearney's Cottage, with traditional Irish songs and Irish dancers B/L/D
Day 9	Cork – Depart to Cork, with visits to the Blarney Castle, Blarney Woolen Mills and Old Jameson Distillery B/L/T
Day 10	Dublin – Depart to Dublin, with stop at the Rock of Cashel. In Dublin, visit the Trinity College Campus to see <i>The Book of Kells</i> and Christ Church Cathedral B/D
Day 11	Dublin – Spend the day exploring Dublin on your own. Evening farewell dinner at The Merry Ploughboy Pub B/D
Day 12	Dublin – Transfer to airport for your return trip to Winnipeg B
