Daily Itinerary		Activity Level Moderate
Day 1	Boston – Depart Winnipeg to Boston. Upon arrival, meet the Tour Director and transfer to the hotel. Remainder of day at leisure	
Day 2	Portland – Drive to Salem. See the Cape Neddick Lighthouse and pass through Portsmouth and Kennebunkport. Continue to Portland for a traditional lobster dinner B/D	
Day 3	Bar Harbor – Drive northeast to Bar Harbor. On the way, see jagged coastlines and rocky beaches. In the evening, experience a classic New England clam bake B/D	
Day 4	North Conway – Journey inland towards the White Mountains, the “rooftop of New England.” En route, experience breathtaking mountain vistas, pristine forestry and world-renowned foliage B	
Day 5	Rutland – Navigate the White Mountains that divide the states of New Hampshire and Vermont to Rutland, with its historic district B	
Day 6	Newport – Continue along Vermont’s Green Mountains. Arrive in Rhode Island and visit the Cliff walk, surrounded by surf and gilded age mansions B	
Day 7	Cape Cod – From the opulence of Newport, continue to the unspoiled natural beauty of Cape Cod B	
Day 8	Cape Cod – Take a short ferry ride to Martha’s Vineyard. Enjoy the day exploring miles of pristine beaches, dramatic clay cliffs, rural landscapes and picturesque waterways B	
Day 9	Boston – Drive to see Plymouth Rock. View Plymouth Harbor and see the Mayflower II. Return to Boston for a Boston Harbor Cruise and visit the USS Constitution. After lunch on your own, explore Quincy Market, Boston’s first marketplace B/D
