## **CAA Manitoba offers free Bike Assist to all Winnipeggers on Bike to Work Day**

*Reliable roadside assistance for bikes available to all on June 20*

WINNIPEG, MB – Cycling commuters won't need to worry about flat tires or broken chains on Bike to Work Day – Friday, June 20.

For one day, CAA Manitoba is offering free Bike Assist services to all Winnipeg cyclists – Member or not - who have broken down and need help getting to work, school or home.

“No matter which way you choose to commute, breaking down along the way is something to be dreaded,” says Angèle Young, Public and Government Affairs Specialist for CAA Manitoba. “Whether by car or bike, we want Winnipeggers to know we are only a phone call away.”

CAA Manitoba's one-of-a-kind Bike Assist service has been available for three years. It allows Members to use any of their annual services calls to receive road side assistance if their bike breaks down. Members can use the service to be transported home or to a bike repair shop of their choice.

Cyclists who need help on Bike to Work Day can call CAA Manitoba at 204-262-6111. The service is only available free-of-charge in Winnipeg between 6 a.m. and midnight on June 20, 2014.
