FREE CAA BIKE ASSIST FOR CYCLISTS TOMORROW

Winnipeg, MB – CAA Manitoba might be best known for tow trucks and battery boosts, but their famous roadside assistance also extends to bicycles in a service called Bike Assist. In celebration of Bike to Work Day Winnipeg on June 19, they will be offering all participants (member or not) this unique service at absolutely no charge.

“No matter how you choose to commute, CAA Manitoba is only ever a phone call away if you need help,” says Angèle Young, Public and Government Affairs Specialist for CAA Manitoba. “It’s that peace of mind we’ve been offering motorists for over 100 years that we can now offer to cyclists as well.”

CAA Manitoba’s one-of-a-kind Bike Assist service has been available for four years. Members can use any of their annual service calls for Bike Assist. Their bike and them can be transported home or to a bike repair shop of their choice.

During tomorrow’s Bike to Work Day Winnipeg, CAA Manitoba will be hosting two pits and expects to see over 400 cyclists. Fifty pit stops will be available throughout the city to pick up coffee, water, food, prizes and other treats.
