Manitoba has second lowest gas prices in Canada *CAA app allows users to see historical trends, compare cities*

Winnipeg, MB: Winnipeggers are waking up to find that gas prices have dropped to \$1.06/L, the lowest price since December 2013, according to the new CAA app and website, [Gas Price Monitor](http://getgasprices.ca) (getgasprices.ca)

The app and website provides the price of gas wherever you are, as well as averages for hundreds of communities, all provinces, and national statistics.

“Manitoba’s gas price are almost the least expensive in Canada, second to only Alberta with a provincial average of \$1.04/L,” says Angele Young, Public and Government Affairs Specialist for CAA Manitoba. “Quebec is the currently the highest at \$1.24/L.”

Here is a summary of today’s statistics for Winnipeg:

- Today’s average price: \$1.07/L
- Last week’s average price: \$1.12/L
- Last month’s average price: \$1.19/L
- November 6, 2013 average price: \$1.14/L
- Lowest price in the past month: \$1.07/L
- Highest price in the past month: \$1.18/L
- Lowest price in the past year (Dec 30, 2013): 1.06/L
- Highest price in the past year (June 11, 2014): \$1.33/L

These statistics are updated regularly and are also available for Brandon, Steinbach, Portage la Prairie and Morris, along with other Canadian cities and provinces.
