<p>1. Stopping in a no-stopping/parking zone <i>A motorist who has stopped or parked for whatever reason in a no-stopping/ no-parking zone/loading zone.</i></p>	68	
<p>2. Speeding <i>A vehicle that is travelling faster than the posted speed limit or too fast for the conditions.</i></p>	173	
<p>3. Not obeying road signs <i>Motorist fails to comply with road signs like: no drop off zone, yield, no parking in parking lot, no entrance, no exit, no right turn on red, etc.</i></p>	28	
<p>4. Motorist fails to stay stopped for a patrol <i>Motorists are to remain stopped until patrols are on the sidewalk.</i></p>	29	
<p>5. Motorists fails to stop at a crosswalk or stop sign <i>Motorist fails to make a complete 3 second stop at a stop sign/stop line. Motorist proceeds into the intersection after the light turns yellow/red. Motorist rolls past the stop sign or stops past the stop sign. Motorist does not stop at all at the stop sign/line/patrols.</i></p>	587	
<p>6. Distracted driving <i>A motorist who is using any sort of handheld device while the vehicle is in motion, driver eating or drinking, putting on makeup etc.</i></p>	79	

<p>7. Pedestrian infractions <i>Pedestrians crossing the street when it is unsafe to do so, not crossing at a crosswalk or by school patrols, failing to look both ways before crossing the street. Pedestrians are texting while crossing the street.</i></p>	<p>129</p>	
<p>8. Cyclist infractions <i>Cyclists not wearing helmets, not signaling to change lanes, failing to dismount when crossing an intersection, etc.</i></p>	<p>130</p>	
<p>9. Changing lanes illegally & Failing to Signal <i>Motorist changes lanes in a crosswalk, on double-solid line, or when it is unsafe to do so. Motorist fails to signal when leaving a parking spot/stopped position.</i></p>	<p>185</p>	
<p>10. Driver smoking in car with children <i>A motorist who is smoking inside the vehicle; where any occupants under the age of 16 are present.</i></p>	<p>0</p>	
<p>11. Improper drop-off in parking lot <i>A motorist leaves car unattended while bringing children inside</i></p>	<p>29</p>	
<p>12. Unsafe drop-off <i>Child has to exit on wrong side of car, has to walk into traffic. Car is not in park or fully stopped when child exits.</i></p>	<p>69</p>	
<p>13. Turning into a bus loop <i>A motorist turns into a bus loop that has signs indicating they are not allowed to do so during school hours.</i></p>	<p>0</p>	

<p>14. Using driveway to turn around or drop-off, reversing out of bus loop, reversing out of back lane. <i>Motorist uses a resident's driveway to turn around or drop off, reversing out of a back lane onto a busy street.</i></p>	<p>18</p>	
<p>15. Other <i>Failing to wear seat belts, other things.</i></p>	<p>92</p>	<p>Three points turns No seatbelts Driving backwards</p>
