INFRACTION	TOTAL # OF OCCURRENCES
1. Stopping in a no-stopping/parking zone OR double parking on street <i>A motorist who has stopped or parked in a no-stopping/no-parking zone.</i>	90
2. Speeding <i>Vehicle travelling faster than the posted speed limit or too fast for the conditions.</i>	76
3. Failure to obey road signs <i>Failure to comply with road signs like: no drop off zone, yield, no parking in parking lot, no entrance, no exit, no left turn, etc.</i>	6
4. Failure to stop for school bus or patrol <i>Driver passes a school bus while lights are flashing, or doesn't stop when school patrol proceeds in intersection.</i>	1
5. Failure to stop at a crosswalk, stop sign, stop line <i>Driver fails to make a complete 3 second stop at a stop sign; Fails to remain at a complete stop until a child has reached the other side of the road in a crosswalk or by patrol. Driver stops over stop line at traffic lights, stop sign or crosswalk. Fails to stop at a crosswalk.</i>	87
6. Distracted driving <i>A motorist who is using any sort of handheld device while the vehicle is in motion, driver eating or drinking, putting on makeup etc.</i>	37

INFRACTION	TOTAL # OF OCCURRENCES
7. Pedestrian infractions <i>Pedestrians crossing when it is unsafe, not crossing at a crosswalk or by school patrols, failing to look both ways before crossing.</i>	29
8. Cyclist infractions <i>Not wearing helmets, not signaling to change lanes, failing to dismount when crossing an intersection, adults biking on sidewalk, etc.</i>	52
9. Changing lanes illegally & failing to signal <i>Motorist changes lanes in a crosswalk, on double-solid line, failing to signal from a parked position or when it is unsafe to do so.</i>	58
10. Driver smoking in car with children <i>A motorist who is smoking inside the vehicle were any occupant under the age of 16 is present.</i>	4
11. Uses staff parking lot for drop off <i>A motorist who uses staff parking lot to turn around or drop child off.</i>	8
12. Unsafe drop-off <i>Child is dropped off at opposite side of street or wrong side of car, has to walk into traffic.</i>	14
13. Turning into bus loop <i>A motorist turns into a bus loop that has signs indicating they are not allowed to do so during school hours.</i>	0
14. Driveway turn around/drop off <i>Motorist uses a resident's driveway to turn around/drop off kids.</i>	41
15. Other <i>Failing to wear seatbelts, no running lights on, others not listed.</i>	45
